Having your vaccine at Hillfoot Surgery

Please read the following information before your COVID-19 vaccination appointment, remember to wear a face covering (unless you are exempt from wearing one), sanitise your hands on arrival and when leaving, and keep your distance ideally two metres apart where possible.

Please attend the portacabin and this will have clear signs, you will not need to enter the practice itself.

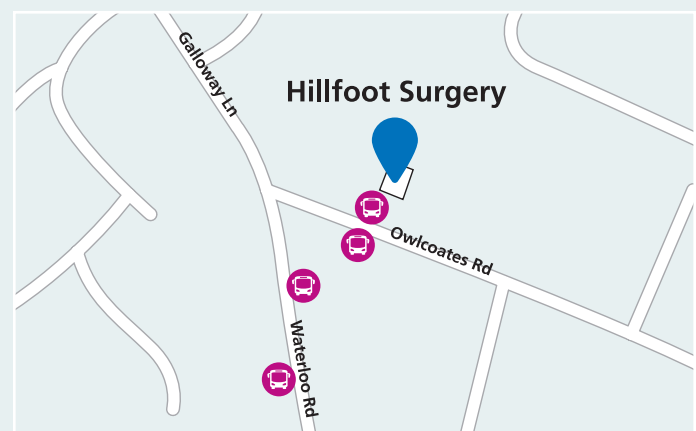
Bringing someone with you to your appointment
